2	Environment Health and Air Pollution
	<p>Please Provide examples of Innovative ideas you have implemented to improve the environment during the period. Examples of work include: Air Quality Monitors, Gen sets controls, Car pooling, Bicycle Use, Construction Dust, Malba, Tree Plantation Drive, Participate in Governments Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) programme etc</p>
3	Waste Management
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken to implement Solid and Wet Waste Management to help reduce the burden on Landfill Sites Examples Include Solid and Wet Waste Management Policies, Community Composting Pits, Domestic Composting, Recycling Bins In Community Areas etc</p>
4	Energy Conservation
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken for Energy Conservation and encourage Renewable Energy in their area during the period. Examples Include Solar Energy plants, Bureau of Energy Efficiency Schemes, Implement "LED" Lighting in all Parks and Common Areas etc</p>
5	Water Conservation
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken to implement Water Conservation in their areas? Examples Include Water Conservation Measures taken at Community level and Household level like Rain Water Harvesting, Introducing New Rain Water Harvesting systems in local Parks, Periodic maintenance of Existing Rain Water Harvesting in Parks, Measures to Recharge Water Table as recommended by Government of NCT of Delhi, Household Surveys of Water Harvesting Status of each household. etc</p>
6	Cleanliness (Swatchh Bharat) and Health
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken towards ensuring good healthy practices and cleanliness of their areas to achieve the objectives of the Swatchh Bharat Mission etc. Examples include cleanliness drives, health camps, dengue/chickengunia/vector borne disease control measures, access to community toilets for men and women within RWA area for use by domestic workers like drivers, labourers etc</p>
7	Transportation and Parking
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken towards limiting the effects of pollution caused by vehicular traffic and encouraging cycles and pedestrians? Examples Include car pooling, parking management, One way systems, No Parking Areas around markets, encouraging pedestrians, provision of encroachment free footpaths, Last Mile Connectivity to local markets, metro stations, bus stops, Removal of old vehicles parked in lanes and bylanes, Encourage use of cycles and public transport, Resolving Parking issues through resident participation, Implementing parking Policy with Resident participation etc</p>
8	Nation Building and Social Initiatives
	<p>What innovative steps have RWA taken towards Nation Building and Social Initiatives Examples Include Blood Donation Camps, Organ Donation Drives, Senior Citizen Programmes, Voluntary Programmes for Educating the Poor, Eye Sight Camps, Medical Camps, Educating Poor Children, Womens Empowerment, Encouraging the Girl Child, Donations for National Disasters and National Causes etc</p>
